

Elementary Uniform Requirements:

In order to better help you with your uniform orders, please use the list below which clearly outlines what your child will be expected to wear throughout their attendance here at MSK. We hope that this quick chart will help organize you in terms of uniform requirements and dressing your child throughout the week. **Please remember to label your child's uniform pieces with a permanent marker, or perhaps you may have a label maker at home.**

Please note that the green and white striped formal shirt will no longer be available for purchase. Returning children that have purchased this shirt already are still very welcome to wear this long sleeved shirt on Mondays as part of the formal uniform.

Please note that you are able to purchase grey dress pants elsewhere other than McCarthy's however they must be grey dress pants. Plain white dress shirts both long and short sleeved are also available to be purchased elsewhere. Should your child not be properly dressed in uniform, you will be notified of such and will be expected to respect our uniform policy accordingly.

<p align="center"><u>Formal Uniform</u></p> <p><u>Girls:</u> Grades 1-3: blazer, white formal blouse (long or short sleeved), green tie, tunic and grey or green tights/knee socks.</p> <p>* Girls in Grades 4-6 only change from above is that they are to wear a kilt instead of the tunic.</p> <p><u>Boys:</u> Grades 1-6: blazer, white formal shirt, green tie, charcoal grey slacks.</p> <p>Please note: Black, brown or navy blue formal shoes will not be worn daily however will be required for picture days, concerts and some trips.</p> <p>Please note that former green and white striped long sleeved shirt can also be worn on this day from previous uniform supplier.</p> <p>White short sleeve dress shirts are acceptable during warmer weather.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Casual Uniform</u></p> <p><u>Girls:</u> Grades 1-3: white collared polo oxford shirt (with or without MSK logo), tunic/skort, grey or green tights/knee socks.</p> <p>* Girls in Grades 4-6 same as above, but can also wear kilt as an option. Tunics are also available for older children to wear on casual days.</p> <p><u>Boys:</u> Grades 1-6: white, oxford polo shirt (with or without MSK logo), charcoal grey slacks/walking shorts</p> <p>All children may also decide to wear the golf shirt, v neck vest or v-neck pullover or zip polo sweatshirt, turtle neck, t-shirt as part of casual uniform.</p> <p>Please note: If you are not wearing the MSK polo shirt, there must be no logo on shirt.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Gym Attire</u></p> <p><u>Girls:</u> Grades 1-6: white, green or mascot MSK gym shirt, green MSK track pants/shorts, white socks. Sweat top is optional depending on the weather. No jewellery to worn during gym day. Only stud earrings excepted.</p> <p><u>Boys:</u> Grades 1-6 white, green or mascot MSK gym shirt, green MSK track pants/shorts, white socks. Sweat top is optional depending on the weather.</p> <p>All children may also decide to wear the golf shirt, v neck vest or v-neck pullover or zip polo sweatshirt as part of the gym attire.</p> <p>*All children from grades 4 to 6 are required to bring a change of clothing and deodorant for gym class as per accordance with the York Board. If you still have the older style tracksuit→ grey track top and track pants/green and white striped track suit you will still be permitted to wear these items as well.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Casual Uniform</u></p> <p><u>Girls:</u> Grades 1-3: white collared polo shirt (with or without MSK logo), tunic/skort, grey tights/knee socks.</p> <p>* Girls in Grades 4-6 same as above, but can also wear kilt as an option. Tunics are also available for older children to wear on casual days.</p> <p><u>Boys:</u> Grades 1-6: white, collared polo shirt (with or without MSK logo), charcoal grey slacks/shorts</p> <p>All children may also decide to wear the golf shirt, v neck vest or v-neck pullover or zip polo sweatshirt, turtle neck, t-shirt as part of casual uniform.</p> <p>Please note: If you are not wearing the MSK polo shirt, there must be no logo on shirt.</p>	<p>All students can wear either their casual uniform or gym uniform on this day.</p> <p>Children will wear their indoor non marking gym shoes throughout the week with their uniform, including their formal uniform. Also, all long hair is to be tied back everyday. Thank you!</p>
